

Brothers North Netball Family Volunteer Levy

Brothers North Netball Club is a successful not for profit organisation run by volunteers. To conduct an effective and efficient club that is continuing to grow each year, we need the help of volunteers in all aspects of running our club

This levy is payable at the beginning of each season by all families and forms part of the first family members registration fees. No player/s will be registered if this levy is not payed.

This levy has been introduced to help encourage our families to become active members of our club.

Previously, we have had helpers completing the necessary work to run our club however we do not want the wonderful people to burn out therefore with a growing club and also taking into account family budgets in the current economic climate, we do not want to continually raise our registration fees. We would much prefer to have many more volunteers helping with fundraising events and the running of our club.

This is an increasingly common way that sports associations and non-for profit organisations overcome the volunteer shortfall and encourage wider participation in the running of the club. We are not trying to raise revenue through this levy, but to raise help!

How the Family Volunteer Levy will work

Each family will pay a \$25 levy once with their first family members' registration fees.

The levy will be refunded in full at the end of the season when 20 volunteer points have been accumulated by your family.

This will be recorded by managers and forwarded to our Volunteer Levy Co-ordinator.

It is solely up to the volunteer to report to their team manager when they have volunteered. Please note if you do NOT have your time recorded, by your manager then you may risk forgoing your refund.

The 20 points can be obtained in the following ways:

Coaching a Team	20
Fill in Coach for a Day	5 (10 max for season)
Managing a Team (Expressions of interests will be submitted and selection will be made by coach and/or exec committee)	20
Umpiring (min of 5 games)	20
Scoring a game	8 (8 max for season)
Attend General Meeting	5 (10 max for season)
PRNA Grounds Duty	5
PRNA Senior Carnival Duties (including scoring/grounds duty)	5 max
PRNA Junior Carnival Duties (including scoring/grounds duty)	5 max
Fundraising BBQ (2 hours)	10 max
Events Brothers are asked to volunteer at, by PRNA or another organisation	10 max
